Note: The Vatican sent the following instructions: “The faithful should be informed of the times of the celebration so that they can prayerfully unite themselves in their home. In this occasion, the means of live (not recorded) televisual or internet broadcasts are helpful.”

Bishop Flores has given this instruction:

* “The pastors are to ensure to livestream the entire Paschal Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Vigil) and not just part of it. Videos are only to be available during the livestream and the faithful are to see this as a sacred moment and not something available at their own discretion.” (*This is in response to the Vatican's instructions.*)
